<b>Modern Foreign Language Requirement (202 level or above)</b>		

- International Studies majors must complete 10 courses (40 hours). Six of the ten courses for the major must be taken at Emory or Oxford College. Directed Study are considered Emory courses if taken at Emory.
- At least 24 of the required hours (6 courses) must be taken in Political Science.
- A maximum of four courses (16 hours) may be satisfied with courses taken “away” from Emory.
- The Modern Foreign Language Requirement does not count towards the 10 courses needed to fulfill the major.
- No more than three 100-level courses may be used for the major.
- No more than four hours of elective credit can be satisfied with internship credit.
- Certain courses may satisfy two or more of the above distribution requirements. For example, a course on the political economy of Asia may well apply to both the concentration requirement (Area II) and the geographic area requirement (Area III); or an advanced seminar. However, in no case will this reduce the total number of hours required to complete the major. The extra hours will be made up in elective credit.
